Dir: Paul Schrader | USA | 2018 | 113mins | (15)

This dark drama stars **Ethan Hawke** (*Boyhood, Before Trilogy*) as a pastor of a small church in upstate New York who spirals out of control after a soul-shaking encounter with an unstable environmental activist and his pregnant wife (**Amanda Seyfried**). ## THE CHILDREN ACT

Dir: Richard Eyre | UK | 2017 | 105mins | (12A)

**Emma Thompson** stars as Fiona Maye, a High Court judge in London presiding over complex cases of family law. She has paid a heavy personal price for her workload and her marriage to American professor Jack (**Stanley Tucci**) is at breaking point. In this moment of personal crisis, she is asked to rule on the most turbulent case of her career. Written by **Ian McEwan** and adapted from his own best-selling novel, the film also stars **Fionn Whitehead** (*Dunkirk*).



## COLD WAR

Dir: Pawel Pawlikowski | Poland/France/UK | 2018 | 88mins | (15)  
Multi-lingual with English subtitles

Set against the background of 1950s Poland, Berlin, Yugoslavia and Paris – *Cold War* depicts an impossible love story in impossible times. Premiering to acclaim at this year’s Cannes Film Festival, the film was nominated for the prestigious Palme d’Or whilst **Pawel Pawlikowski** (*Ida*) won Best Director.

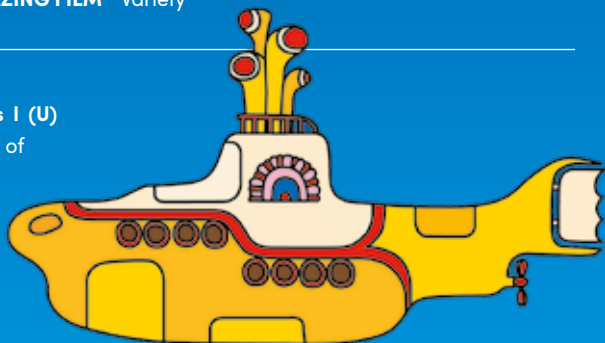
## YELLOW SUBMARINE

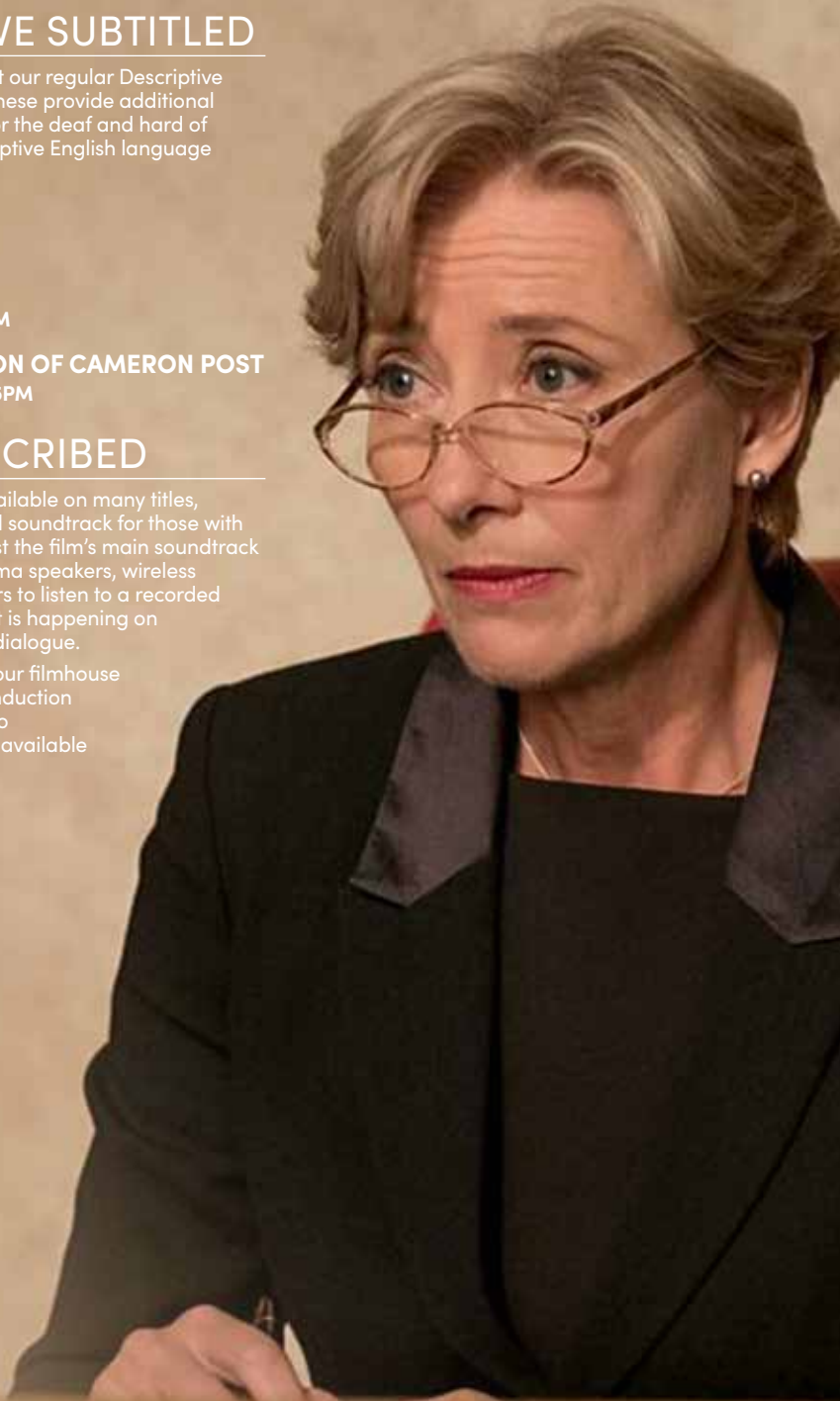

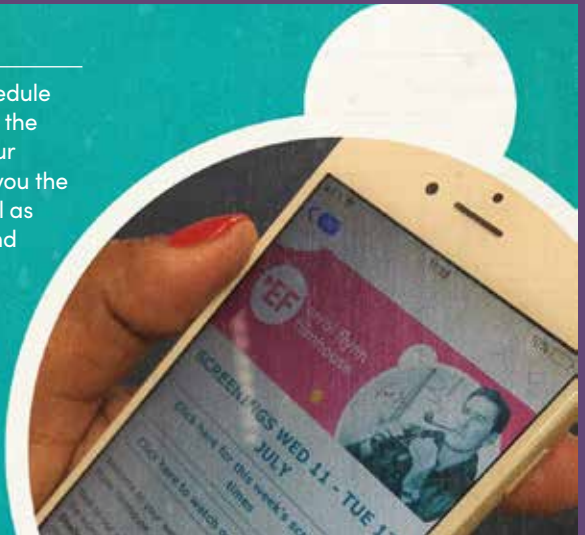
