## THE LITTLE STRANGER

Dir: Lenny Abrahamson | UK | 2018 | 111mins | (12A)

**Lenny Abrahamson** (*Room*) directs this story of Dr Faraday (**Domhnall Gleeson**, *Goodbye Christopher Robin*), the son of a housemaid, who has built a life of quiet respectability as a country doctor in this adaptation of **Sarah Waters'** acclaimed novel. After being called to a patient at Hundreds Hall, he finds its inhabitants haunted by something ominous. Also starring **Ruth Wilson** (*Saving Mr Banks*), **Will Poulter** (*The Revenant*) and **Charlotte Rampling** (*45 Years*).



## THE SEAGULL

Dir: Michael Mayer | USA | 2018 | 99mins | (12A)

In the early 20th century, an aging actress and her lover visit the estate of her elderly brother. Adapted from **Anton Chekhov's** classic play, the film is directed by Tony-winner **Michael Mayer** (*Spring Awakening*) and features an all-star cast including **Saoirse Ronan**, **Elisabeth Moss**, **Corey Stoll** and **Annette Bening**.

## KING OF THIEVES
